



Northern Gateway Toll Road



As you approach the toll point

There are no toll booths to stop and pay - you simply drive along the toll road



An image is captured

As you pass under the toll point, cameras capture an image of your vehicle's registration plate number



Your toll is calculated

The system determines the type of vehicle you're driving from your registration plate and assigns the correct toll



Ways to pay

You can pay by toll road account or online for no extra payment charge. Purchases made using the kiosk or phone will attract extra payment charges per transaction

HOW MUCH?

The toll road costs (each way):

Light vehicle or Motorcycle	\$2.20
Heavy vehicle (exceeding 3.5 tonnes)	\$4.40
There is no additional charge for towing a caravan or trailer	

Tariffs are correct at the time of printing and are subject to change. Visit www.tollroad.govt.nz or see on-road signage for the current tariff.

DIFFERENT WAYS TO PAY YOUR TOLL

The benefit of electronic tolling is that you can pay at your convenience rather than interrupting your journey.

You can set up an account and have all your tolls paid automatically.

Otherwise, you can pay in advance or within five days of using the toll road.

To pay by cash, credit card or Eftpos visit a cash payment point* at

- SH1 BP Connect Dairy Flat (travelling north)
- SH1 Titford's Bridge, on your left, after the Puhoi turnoff (travelling south).

*If you choose to pay for your tolls at the cash payment points you will incur a payment charge of 40 cents per payment OR by phone you will be charged \$3.70 per payment made using the contact centre.



Free alternative

It doesn't cost anything to use the existing free route. Access it by exiting SH1 via Waiwera or Silverdale (see map).
